PL-11 Attract Bees with these Plants

Plant a wide variety of colors, shapes and sizes of flowers for bees. Their favorite colors are blue, purple and yellow. Group several of the same plants together so there are plenty of blossoms. Ideally there should be something blooming from early spring through fall. Provide a shallow source of water. This plant list will get you started.
