

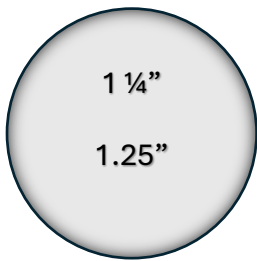
House Wren: • May-September • Woodland/Town • Uses spider egg sacs to keep out bugs

Chickadee: Black Capped: • April-July • Forest/Town • Nests in rotting wood cavities

Mountain: • April-August • Mountain • Eggs are covered using fur

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Yellow Warbler: • Early Spring • Open woodlands/wetlands • Often nests in shrubs

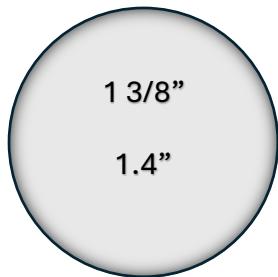

Red-Breasted Nuthatch: • April-June • Forests • Nests in dead trees

Tufted Titmouse: • March-July • Woodland • Nests are reused in later years

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White-Breasted Nuthatch: • March-June • Deciduous forests • Reuses nests

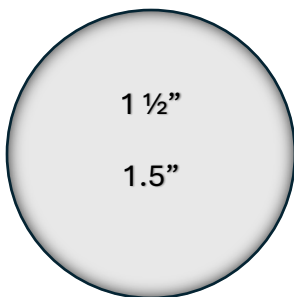

Violet-green swallow: • May-August • Woodland • Colony Layer (25+ birds)

Tree Swallow: • May-July • Grasslands • Needs river/stream nearby

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East/Western Bluebird: • April-July • Woodland • Helps others build nests

Bewick/Carolina Wren: • April-August • Desert/Woodland • Lays in cavities
