With the heat comes more's nighttime feeding insects like earwigs that eat holes in leaves leaving them looking like lace. Treat earwigs with Bug & Slug Killer, or Diatomaceous Earth. Also, avoid watering at night so that insects aren't attracted to your garden. unna

Spider Mites are on the rise & can be problematic with both evergreen & deciduous trees. shrubs.& perennials. Treat with Neem Oil or Mite X, according to directions. in early morning or late afternoon.



BLOOMING SUMMER!

Perk up your flower beds with late summer-bloomins perennials like asters. mums & anemones.





Watch closely for signs of scorch on tender new foliage - the margins of

leaves turn brown and crispy -

indicating lack of water and/or

exposure to hot drying winds.

CONTROL SUCKING INSECT PESTS, INCLUDING APHIDS, MEALYBUGS, SCALE, SPIDER MITES, THRIPS, & WHITEFLY WITH LADY BUGS OR FERTILOME TRIPLE ACTION PLUS OR BONIDE INSECTICIDAL SOAP.



FOR CHEWING INSECTS SUCH

AS CATERPILLARS, USE FERTILOME

Monitor tomatoes and ensure that they receive an even supply of moisture instead of heavy soaking & then a drought.

DID YOU KNOW?



spreading a 3" layer of nutrient rich organic mulch around plants reduces water usage by up to 30%.

PRUNING IS NOT ADVISED THIS MONTH

EXCEPT FOR SHRUBS THAT HAVE JUST FLOWERED; PRUNE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THEIR FLOWERING

Rufous hummingbirds will be arriving in the area and will stay until fall, so keep feeders full of fresh sugar water. Change nectar every few days to avoid spoilage.

MANAMAMAMAMA

MANY BIRDS CONTINUE THEIR MAIN MOLT THROUGH AUGUST, WHICH REQUIRES EXTRA PROTEIN FOR THE NEXT FEW MONTHS. OFFER HIGH-PROTEIN BIRD FOODS, TO ENSURE THAT YOUR BIRDS HAVE A RELIABLE SOURCE OF PROTEIN TO HELP THEM WITH MOLTING.
